

Ability to Print Notes on SF Forms

Subareas are now available to print SouthWare notes on selected SF Forms. These subareas offer flexible width and the option to select a specific note category. FlowPoints are also available so that you may use WorkFlow FlowMods to conditionally control whether a subarea prints on a form. This gives you the option to define multiple notes subareas and conditionally print only the ones that apply in a given situation.

The forms that support this feature are:

- ✓ **Sales Order Picking Ticket**
- ✓ **Order Acknowledgement**
- ✓ **Invoice**
- ✓ **Quote**
- ✓ **Service Order**
- ✓ **Service Order Picking Ticket**
- ✓ **Purchase Order**

Available Notes Subareas

The notes subareas are:

- For Header area
 - HDRNOTE1
 - HDRNOTE2
 - HDRNOTE3
 - HDRNOTE4
 - HDRNOTE5
- For Item area
 - ITMNOTE1
 - ITMNOTE2
 - ITMNOTE3
 - ITMNOTE4
 - ITMNOTE5
- For Trailing area
 - TRLNOTE1
 - TRLNOTE2
 - TRLNOTE3
 - TRLNOTE4
 - TRLNOTE5

The notes subareas will always print after the related text areas:

- Header notes will print after header text
- Line item notes will print after line item text
- Trailing notes will print after trailing text

Available FlowPoints

FlowPoints for the subareas are the same in each forms print program. Each FlowPoint has FAIL logic to omit the subarea:

Subareas: HDRNOTE(1-5) FlowPoint 8450 – 8454
LINENOTE (1-5) FlowPoint 8455 – 8459
TRAILNOTE (1-5) FlowPoint 8460 - 8464

Data names for each subarea

HEADNOTE(HDRNOTE subarea)

LINENOTE (ITMNOTE subarea)

TRAILNOTE (TRLNOTE subarea)

Each data name has these parameters: @NKEY, @NCATEG, @NWIDTH, @NFORM: Use these parameters to override the defaults

Defaults:

@NKEY (notes key): Primary file for the form area

@NCATEG (notes category): Notes with a blank category

@NWIDTH (The width of the notes text): 30

@NFORM (Type of form this type of note applies to): All forms in the forms print program

Override Parameters:

@NKEY – notes key DD field (DD file – ex. AR010093)

@NCATEG – note category (use literal “ALL” to print all notes)

@NWIDTH – line length (30 to 132)

@NFORM – form type (ex. OE02)

Examples

Example definition to print notes with category of M from the order header starting at column 22 for a width of 80 characters: applies to form OE02 ONLY

```
@SUBAREA_START=HDRNOTE1
```

```
@LIN
```

```
  @COL=22 , <HEADNOTE>,@NCATEG=M,@NWIDTH=80,@NFORM=OE02
```

```
@SUBAREA_END=HDRNOTE1
```

Example definition to print notes for all categories from the customer on the order header starting at column 22

```
@SUBAREA_START=HDRNOTE2
```

```
@LIN
```

```
  @COL=22 , <HEADNOTE>,@NKEY=AR010093,@NCATEG=ALL
```

```
@SUBAREA_END=HDRNOTE2
```

Example definition to print notes with blank category from the order header starting at column 22 (Uses the defaults of Order Header Notes with blank category on all invoice related forms with a width of 30 characters)

```
@SUBAREA_START=HDRNOTE1
```

```
@LIN
```

```
  @COL=22, <HEADNOTE>
```

```
@SUBAREA_END=HDRNOTE1
```

Primary Files

In all the print programs, any note can be printed from any file that is accessible from the form's primary file:

- Purchase Order Primary file:
 - HDRNOTE:IV05
 - TRLNOTE:IV05
 - ITMNOTE:IV06
- Invoice/Order Primary file:
 - HDRNOTE:RS07
 - TRLNOTE:RS07
 - ITMNOTE:RS08
- Collections Invoice Primary file:
 - HDRNOTE:RS10
 - TRLNOTE:RS10
 - ITMNOTE:RS11
- Sales Order Picking Ticket Primary file:
 - HDRNOTE:RS07
 - TRLNOTE:RS07
 - ITMNOTE:RS08
- Service Order Primary file:
 - HDRNOTE:SV04
 - TRLNOTE:SV04
 - ITMNOTE:SV06
- History Primary file-
 - HDRNOTE:SV14
 - TRLNOTE:SV14
 - ITMNOTE: SV16
- Service Order Picking Ticket Primary file:
 - HDRNOTE:SV04
 - TRLNOTE:SV04
 - ITMNOTE:SV06
